easter egg marbling



A kid-friendly Easter egg marbling activity to try at home!

Materials

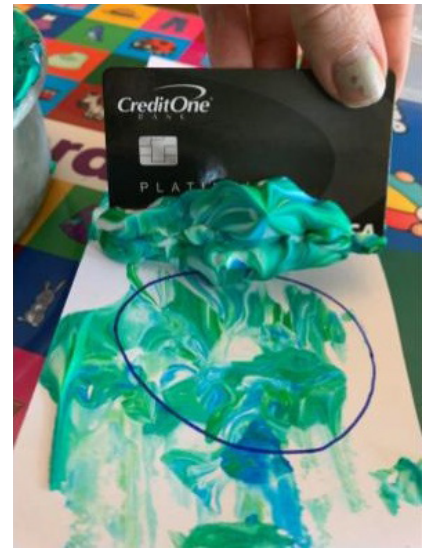
- Shaving cream
- Food coloring (or watercolors)
- Containers
- Paper towels
- Hard boiled eggs and egg templates
- A spoon

Instructions

1. Begin by adding shaving cream to your container. You want to make sure you have enough to cover the bottom of your container and be able to cover your hard-boiled egg.
2. Next, add several drops of food coloring to your shaving cream.



3. Place the egg in the shaving cream and cover it with the food coloring.
4. Remove the egg along with some of the shaving cream and let it rest.



5. After about 5 minutes carefully wipe the shaving cream off the eggs. You can also create marbled paper eggs by placing the paper into the shaving cream and removing the excess with hard plastic such as a gift card.



Now you have beautifully marbled Easter eggs!
